

Why were people waiting for the Jesus to be born? I thinking of an old man by the name of Simeon who received a promise that he would not die before seeing Jesus. I think God gave Simeon that promise to help him deal with all the injustice he saw around him. He was living in oppressive Roman empire that was run by wicked people. God's response to their cry for freedom was to send Jesus to deliver them from oppression.

1. God prepares your blessing as you do what right .

²¹ *And when eight days were completed for the circumcision of the Child, His name was called JESUS, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb. Luke 2:21 (NKJV)*

2. God helps you when you put your gifts in his hands .

²² *Now when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord Luke 2:22 (NKJV)*

3. Giving is part of thanking God for our gifts .

²⁴ *So they offered the sacrifice required in the law of the Lord—“either a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons.” Luke 2:24 (NLT)*

²⁶ *and had revealed to him that he would not die until he had seen the Lord's Messiah Luke 2:26 (NLT).*

6. God helps us be in the right place at the right time .

²⁷ *That day the Spirit led him to the Temple. So when Mary and Joseph came to present the baby Jesus to the Lord as the law required, Luke 2:27 (NLT)*

³⁰ *I have seen your salvation, ³¹ which you have prepared for all people. ³² He is a light to reveal God to the nations, and he is the glory of your people Israel!” Luke 2:30-32 (NLT)*

10. Let your spirit witness what you know is true

³³ *Jesus' parents were amazed at what was being said about him.*

³⁴ *Then Simeon blessed them, and he said to Mary, the baby's mother, “This child is destined to cause many in Israel to fall, but he will be a joy to many others. He has been sent as a sign from God, but many will oppose him. Luke 2:33-34 (NLT)*
