

## The 10<sup>th</sup> Plague the Death of the Firstborn Males

The tenth and last plague, the death of the firstborn males, was a judgment on Isis, the protector of children. In this plague, God was teaching the Israelites a deep spiritual lesson that pointed to Christ. Unlike the other plagues, which the Israelites survived by virtue of their identity as God's people, this plague required an act of faith by them. The act of faith was the sacrifice of a lamb. God held the heart of the Egyptian people in his hand. This is seen as the Egyptians gave gifts to the Israelites. God was letting the people know that there is no protection from him. This plague reminds us that we are all in the hands of God. We all need God's protection from dangers we can't even comprehend. Let us learn to be grateful for the protection God gives us.

*So Moses said, "This is what the LORD says: 'About midnight I will go throughout Egypt. Exodus 11:4 (NIV)*

*Every firstborn son in Egypt will die, from the firstborn son of Pharaoh, who sits on the throne, to the firstborn son of the slave girl, who is at her hand mill, and all the firstborn of the cattle as well. Exodus 11:5 (NIV)*

*There will be loud wailing throughout Egypt--worse than there has ever been or ever will be again. Exodus 11:6 (NIV)*

*But among the Israelites not a dog will bark at any man or animal.' Then you will know that the LORD makes a distinction between Egypt and Israel. Exodus 11:7 (NIV)*

**8. God's plans always work for the good \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*All these officials of yours will come to me, bowing down before me and saying, 'Go, you and all the people who follow you!' After that I will leave." Then Moses, hot with anger, left Pharaoh. Exodus 11:8 (NIV)*
